

# FEROCIOUS feline fiend

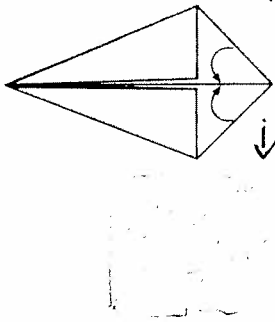
*If you let this black cat slink across your path, be ready for lots of bad luck.*

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

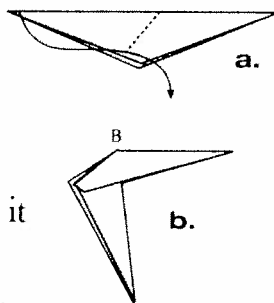
black origami paper • white paper • puff paint • pencil • glue

## DIRECTIONS

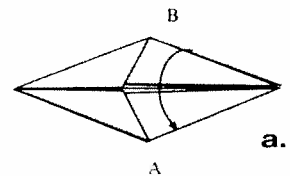
- 1** Start with Basic Form 1, turning it so the wider half is on the right. Then *open*, fold the top and bottom edges on the right to the center line.



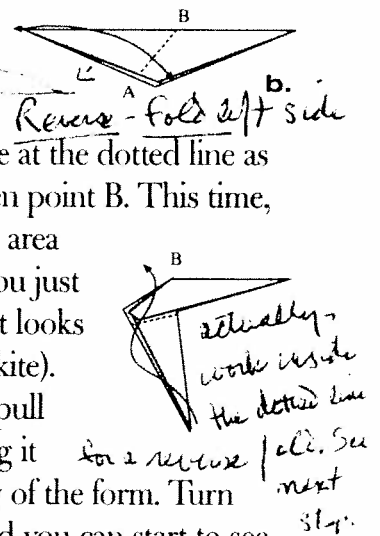
- 3** Tightly pinch the left corner of the form. Open point B so it forms a kite shape, then inside-reverse fold it so it tucks inside the form. When this step is complete, it should look like the illustration B.



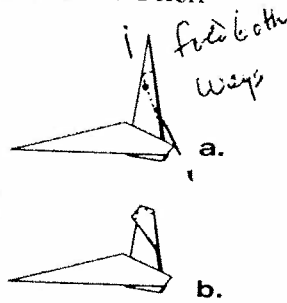
- 2** Fold the form in half top to bottom, and make a crease from point A to the middle of the top edge, point B, as shown. Make sure the crease is sharp and the next step will be easy.



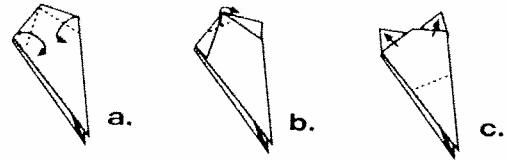
- 4** Now make a crease at the dotted line as shown. Again, open point B. This time, push down on the area above the crease you just made (the area that looks like the top of the kite). At the same time, pull point B up, tucking it back into the body of the form. Turn your form over, and you can start to see the head and body of your cat.



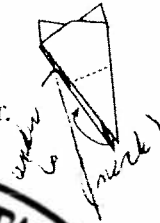
- 5** Make two creases as shown. Then poke your finger at the point where the two creases meet and do a squash fold to form the fearsome feline's head.



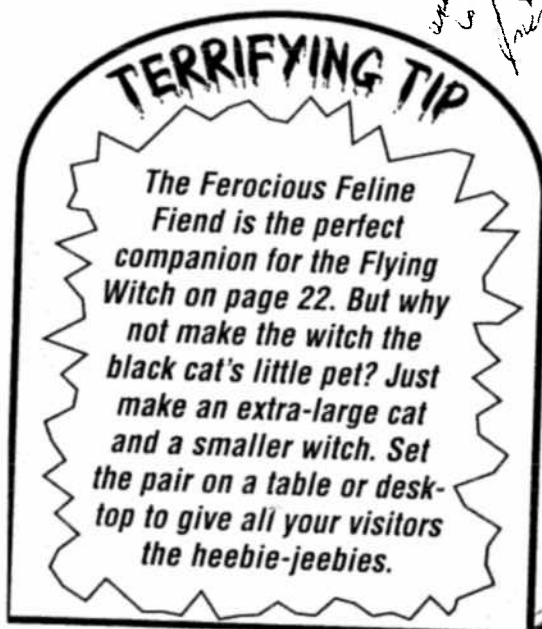
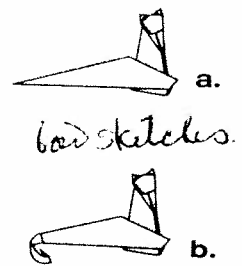
- 6** The two points on either side are the cat's ears, which you must first fold down in valley folds. Then use a mountain fold to fold the top of the head back, and complete the ears by lifting the two points back up.



- 7** Tuck the point at the bottom of the cat's face under.



- 8** Use puff paint to make the cat's eyes, nose, whiskers, and mouth. Glue on large white fangs cut from paper. Lay a pencil at the end of the tail and curl it tightly, then pull the pencil out.



*Curving the tail allows it to sit up.*
